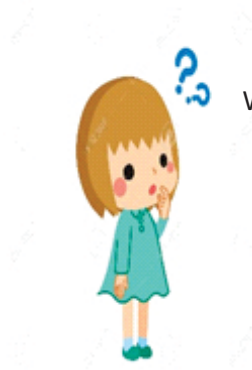

What are collective nouns?

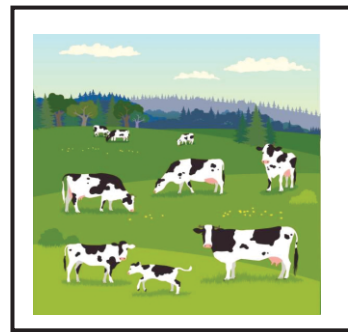
A collective noun is a word that describes a group of things animals or people as a single unit
